

## ANDES EXTENSIONS HACIENDA ZULETA (2N/3D)

Combine your experience at Galapagos Safari Camp with a two-night stay at Hacienda Zuleta, just two hours from Quito, Ecuador. Dating from the late XVI century, Hacienda Zuleta is a 4,000 acre colonial working farm that belongs to the family of Mr. Galo Plaza Lasso, a former president of Ecuador. The hacienda features 15 beautifully decorated bedrooms, all with their own fireplace, as well as cozy living rooms and wonderful grounds. Delicious Ecuadorian cuisine is prepared with organic vegetables, dairy products, and trout from the hacienda.

### ›DAY 1 - A piece of Andean history

Drive through the Andes for 2.5 hours to Hacienda Zuleta (or take a 20-minute helicopter ride, available on request). If you have a full day you may visit the Otavalo market. Once you settle in Zuleta, you can explore the property, relax by the

fire, or browse through the impressive library. A delectable Andean dinner is served, made with local organic produce.

### ›DAY 2 - The flight of the condor

Hacienda Zuleta offers a number of activities for its guests, including horse-riding, hiking, and mountain-biking. The Zuleteño horse is a unique combination of Andalusian, English, and Quarter horses; the outcome of this cross-breeding is a robust, noble, and smooth Andean horse with a perfect disposition for trail riding. Discover the Condor-Huasi route along grassy trails, with ancient pyramids along the way; visit the condor project, which is dedicated to the rehabilitation of the majestic Andean Condor; or explore the hacienda by horse-drawn carriage, guaranteed unforgettable.

### ›DAY 3 - The farm & return to Quito

After breakfast, explore the organic garden, feed the calves, watch vaqueros in action, visit the embroidery museum, take a tour of the cheese factory, or relax in the garden before your transfer back to Quito.
